2024 HONOR AWARDS

DEADLINE EXTENDED TO SEPTEMBER 12

The AIA Miami Board of Directors is seeking nominations for its **2024 Honor Awards Program**. The Chapter seeks to recognize achievements for contribution to design, construction and public service related to architecture, the building arts and urban design.

Architect of the Year (AIA Miami Members Only)

Recognizes an architect who has made special contributions to the profession whether through excellence in design, service to the Chapter, or in raising public awareness of the role of architecture in the community.

Sustainable Design Architect of the Year (AIA Miami Members Only)

Presented to an architect that has made a major contribution to sustainable/resilient building practices, either by way of project design, research, or advocacy.

Emerging Professional of the Year (AIA Miami Members Only)

Presented to an architect in the first ten years of his or her career since licensing who has made an impact on the profession in terms of design excellence or service to the profession.

Associate of the Year (AIA Miami Members Only)

Recognizes an Associate Member who has made special contributions to the profession whether through excellence in design, service to the Chapter, or in raising public awareness of the role of architecture in the community.

Citizen Architect (AIA Miami Members Only)

Individuals are eligible if they have demonstrated civic engagement by being elected to public office; serving on a public board, commission, or committee, either as AIA representative or individually as an architect; demonstrated a commitment to community outreach as an architect, including providing pro-bono services for government, a school or a non-profit community organization; involved in advocacy activities intended to improve the built environment and social equity.

Leadership in Education

Recognizes a member of the academic community who has made a special contribution to the field of architectural or urban design education.

Leadership in Government

Presented to an elected official or public staff member who has made a significant contribution to the awareness of architectural or urban design issues, who has participated in the public side of the design process in such a way as to make a positive contribution to the built environment.

General Contractor of the Year

Presented to a contractor who through the quality of his or her work and the professionalism of his or her service has raised the standards of the building arts.

Allied Member of the Year

Recognizes an AIA Miami Allied Member who has made a special contribution to the industry and through their support of AIA Miami.

Consulting Engineer of the Year

Recognizes a consulting engineer who has made a significant contribution to the advancement of the profession of building engineering or achievement in engineering design.

All nominations must be received by 5:00 PM, September 12, 2024. No submissions after that will be accepted.

Awards will be presented at the AIA Miami Design Awards Celebration on October 18, 2024.

Individuals are encouraged to nominate themselves and/or others by submitting the information requested below. Nominations will not be considered without supporting documentation.

1. Category for Nomination
2. Name of the Nominee
3. Description of why the nominee is deserving of this award (min. 300 words, to be attached and should not exceed one page)
4. Supporting documentation such as project pages, copies of awards or other recognition, bio, resume, etc. must be attached. Any project pages submitted shall be kept to one 8.5 x 11 page per project and should include images and text explaining why the project is applicable. Project pages are not required as not all award categories are project-based. Copies of awards or other documentation should include a brief description of why the information submitted is applicable. This section should not exceed 10 pages.
5. Applications (not to exceed 10 megabytes) will only be accepted electronically at marilyn@aiami.org in an Adobe Acrobat (.pdf) format.
